The school's biggest fundraising event of the year will be kicking off in just a few short weeks. We will be communicating with you regularly with updates via email, social media, and flyers. In the meantime, here is a list of frequently asked questions (FAQ) to get you acquainted with the event.

What is the Fun Glow Run?

The Fun Glow Run, orchestrated by HNPS Home & School organization, is a fundraising event that gets everyone involved--friends and families, local businesses, and most importantly the students.

What does it entail?

The Fun Glow Run takes place over 8 days. The main pep rally kicks off on Wednesday, March 2nd, with mini pep rallies each day leading up to the final "run" for 45 minutes on March 11, 2022.

When is it and what time will my child "run"?

The Glow Run will take place during school on March 11th. Each grade will "run" individually at the following times. Parents are invited and encouraged to come watch their child participate! Note that we have a very full day with very brief transition times so we will need to strictly enforce end times and ask that parents leave the gym directly after their students run is over. This will help to ensure that everything runs on time and that there is enough room for the next set of parents to come in.

What are we raising money for?

All funds raised go directly to HNPS and support important school initiatives. In addition to supporting the school operating budget, monies raised will go towards the school library, including diversifying our book collection, purchasing new books, and updating and remodeling the physical space.

What if my student does not like to run?

Don't worry! The "run" consists of 35 laps around the gym that are choreographed to a soundtrack that tells students what types of laps--slow motion, skip, silly, and more-- to do. This is not a race. It's meant to be fun!

How does my student raise money?

Students help to raise money by asking friends and family to pledge a certain amount of money per lap. Payment is made according to how many laps the student completes (up to 35).

When does pledging opening? How do I collect pledges?

Pledging opens on Wednesday, February 16th. All pledges are made and money collected through an online tool. You will receive more details on how to set-up your child's account in the upcoming weeks so he/she will be ready to ask friends and family for their support.

Are there prizes?

Students can win prizes based on nightly challenges as well as classroom and individual participation.

Can I volunteer?

Yes you can volunteer and earn your hours! Volunteers are needed to help with the pep rallies, set-up, day of run, and clean-up. There will be a sign-up link sent out shortly. Volunteers will need to bring their 2021-2022 HNPS volunteer cards.
